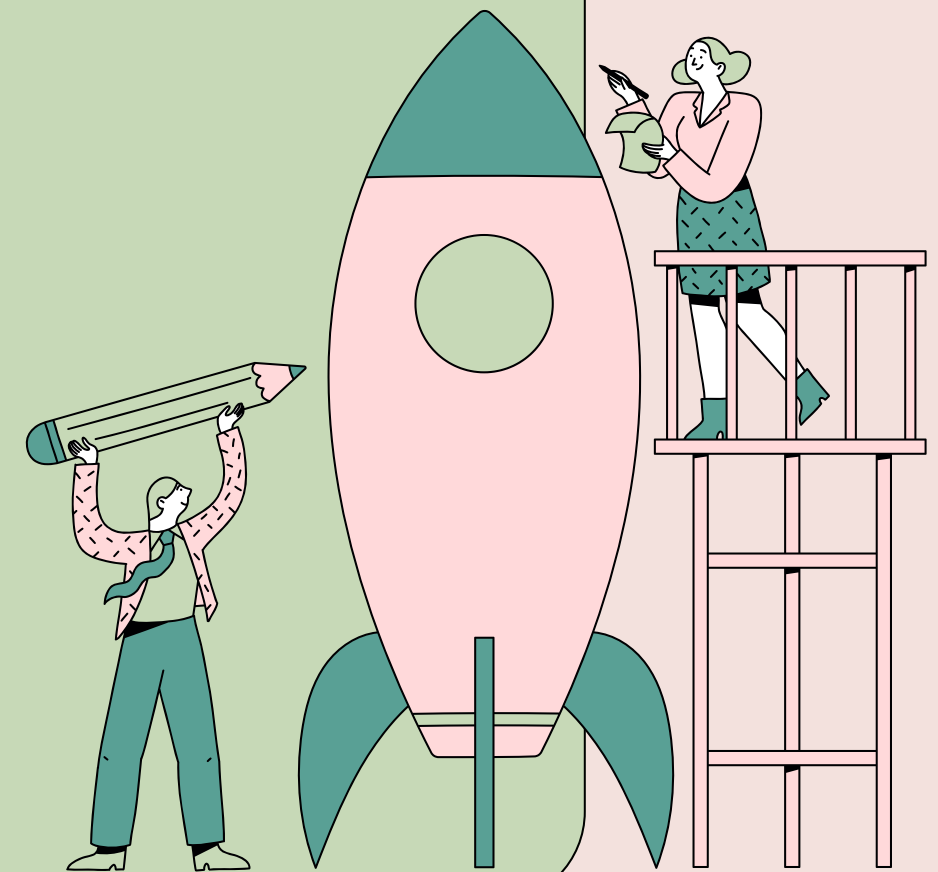

IF YOU DON'T APOLOGIZE, I WILL NEVER SPEAK TO YOU AGAIN.

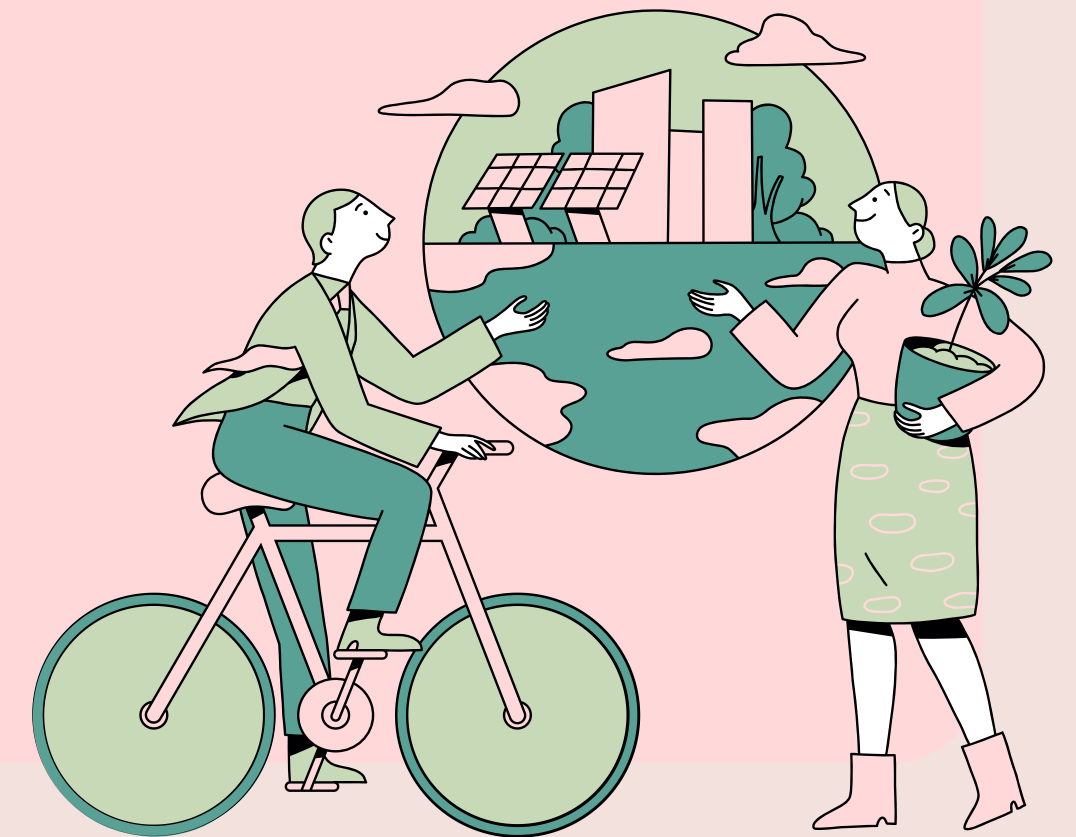
1.PREDICCIONES SIN EVIDENCIA U OPINIONES

ESTRUCTURA: FUTURE SIMPLE CON “WILL”

AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES		
subject	will	infinitive
I/ he/she/it/ we/you/they	will	go

NEGATIVE SENTENCES		
subject	will + not	infinitive
I/ he/she/it/ we/you/they	won't	go

INTERROGATIVE SENTENCES		
will	subject	infinitive + ?
will	I/ he/she/it/ we/you/they	go...?

WE'RE GOING TO MOVE TO A NEW HOUSE NEXT MONTH.

1. PREDICCIONES BASADAS EN EVIDENCIA ACTUAL

LOOK AT THOSE CLOUDS! IT'S GOING TO RAIN.

THE SKY IS GETTING DARK. IT'S GOING TO BE A STORM SOON.

1. INTENCIONES PERSONALES

I'M GOING TO START EXERCISING MORE OFTEN.

I'M GOING TO LEARN HOW TO PLAY THE GUITAR.



ESTRUCTURA: FUTURE SIMPLE CON "BE GOING TO"

AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES

subject	verbo "to be"	going to	infinitive
I/ he/she/it/we/you/they	am / are / is	going to	go

NEGATIVE SENTENCES

subject	verbo "to be" + not	going to	infinitive
I/ he/she/it/we/you/they	am not / aren't / isn't	going to	go

INTERROGATIVE SENTENCES

verbo "to be"	going to	subject	infinitive + ?
Am / Are / Is	going to	I/ he/she/it/we/you/they	go...?

"PRESENT SIMPLE"

1. HORARIOS Y PROGRAMAS FIJOS

THE TRAIN LEAVES AT 7 PM.

THE MOVIE STARTS AT 8:30.

1. EVENTOS OFICIALES O PLANIFICADOS

THE CONFERENCE BEGINS NEXT MONDAY.

THE SCHOOL TERM ENDS IN JUNE.

1. EN ORACIONES CONDICIONALES Y TEMPORALES

I'LL CALL YOU WHEN I ARRIVE.

IF IT RAINS, WE'LL CANCEL THE PICNIC.



ESTRUCTURA: FUTURE SIMPLE CON “PRESENT SIMPLE”

AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES	
subject	infinitive (+ -s o -es en 3ª Persona)
I/ he/she/it/we/you/they	go / goes

NEGATIVE SENTENCES		
subject	do / does + not	infinitive
I/ he/she/it/we/you/they	do not / does not (don't / doesn't)	go

INTERROGATIVE SENTENCES		
Do / Does	subject	infinitive + ?
Do / Does	I/ he/she/it/we/you/they	go...?



FUTURE SIMPLE CON

"PRESENT CONTINUOUS"

¿CUANDO USAMOS EL FUTURE SIMPLE CON “PRESENT CONTINUOUS”?

1- PLANES FUTUROS YA ORGANIZADOS

WE ARE MEETING JOHN FOR LUNCH TOMORROW.

I AM FLYING TO NEW YORK NEXT WEEK.

2- EVENTOS QUE SE HAN ACORDADO

THEY ARE GETTING MARRIED NEXT SUMMER.

SHE IS HAVING A MEETING WITH HER BOSS AT 3 PM.

3- ACCIONES QUE ESTÁN POR SUCEDER EN UN FUTURO CERCANO

I AM LEAVING IN FIVE MINUTES.

WE ARE LEAVING FOR THE AIRPORT IN THE MORNING.



ESTRUCTURA: FUTURE SIMPLE CON “PRESENT CONTINUOUS”

AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES		
subject	verbo “to be”	infinitive + ing
I/ he/she/it/we/you/they	am / are / is	going

NEGATIVE SENTENCES		
subject	verbo “to be” + not	infinitive + ing
I/ he/she/it/we/you/they	am not / aren’t / isn’t	going

INTERROGATIVE SENTENCES		
verbo “to be”	subject	infinitive + ing + ?
Am / Are / Is	I/ he/she/it/we/you/they	going...?



FUTURE SIMPLE CON

"SHALL"

¿CUANDO USAMOS EL FUTURE SIMPLE CON "SHALL"?

EL FUTURO SIMPLE CON "SHALL" SE UTILIZA EN INGLÉS, SOBRE TODO EN INGLÉS BRITÁNICO, PARA EXPRESAR EL FUTURO, AUNQUE ES MENOS COMÚN QUE "WILL". "SHALL" ES MÁS FORMAL Y SE SUELE EMPLEAR PRINCIPALMENTE CON LOS PRONOMBRES "I" Y "WE".

1- SUGERENCIAS O PROPUESTAS

SHALL WE GO FOR A WALK?

SHALL I OPEN THE WINDOW?

2- OFRECIMIENTOS

SHALL I HELP YOU WITH YOUR HOMEWORK?

SHALL WE BRING SOME DRINKS TO THE PARTY?

3- PROMESAS O COMPROMISOS FORMALES

I SHALL NEVER FORGET YOUR KINDNESS.

YOU SHALL RECEIVE A FULL REFUND.

4- INSTRUCCIONES O DECISIONES FORMALES

THE TENANT SHALL PAY THE RENT ON THE FIRST DAY OF EACH MONTH.



ESTRUCTURA: FUTURE SIMPLE CON “SHALL”

AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES		
subject	shall	infinitive
I/ he/she/it/ we/you/they	shall	go

NEGATIVE SENTENCES		
subject	shall+ not	infinitive
I/ he/she/it/ we/you/they	shall not (shan't)	go

INTERROGATIVE SENTENCES		
shall	subject	infinitive + ?
shall	I/ he/she/it/ we/you/they	go...?
