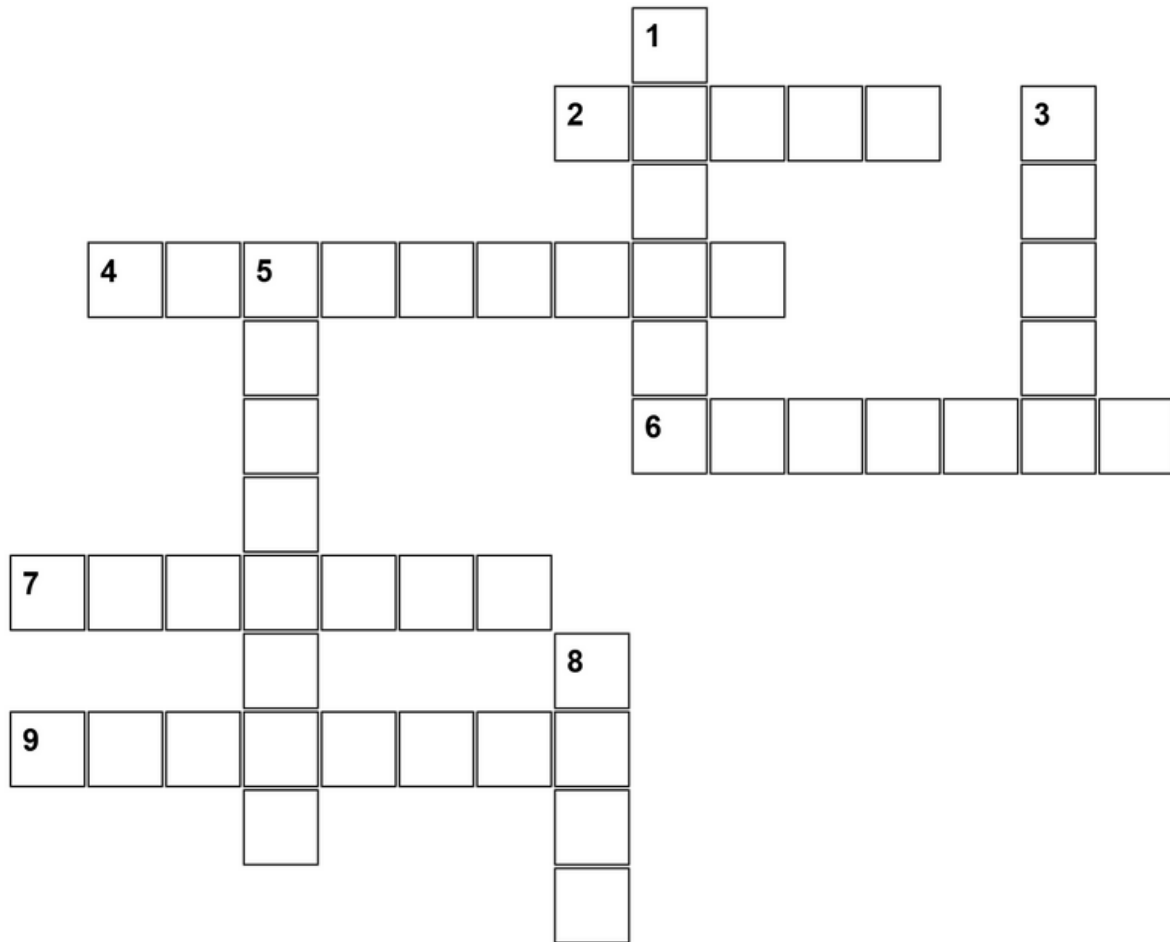


Christmas Crossword



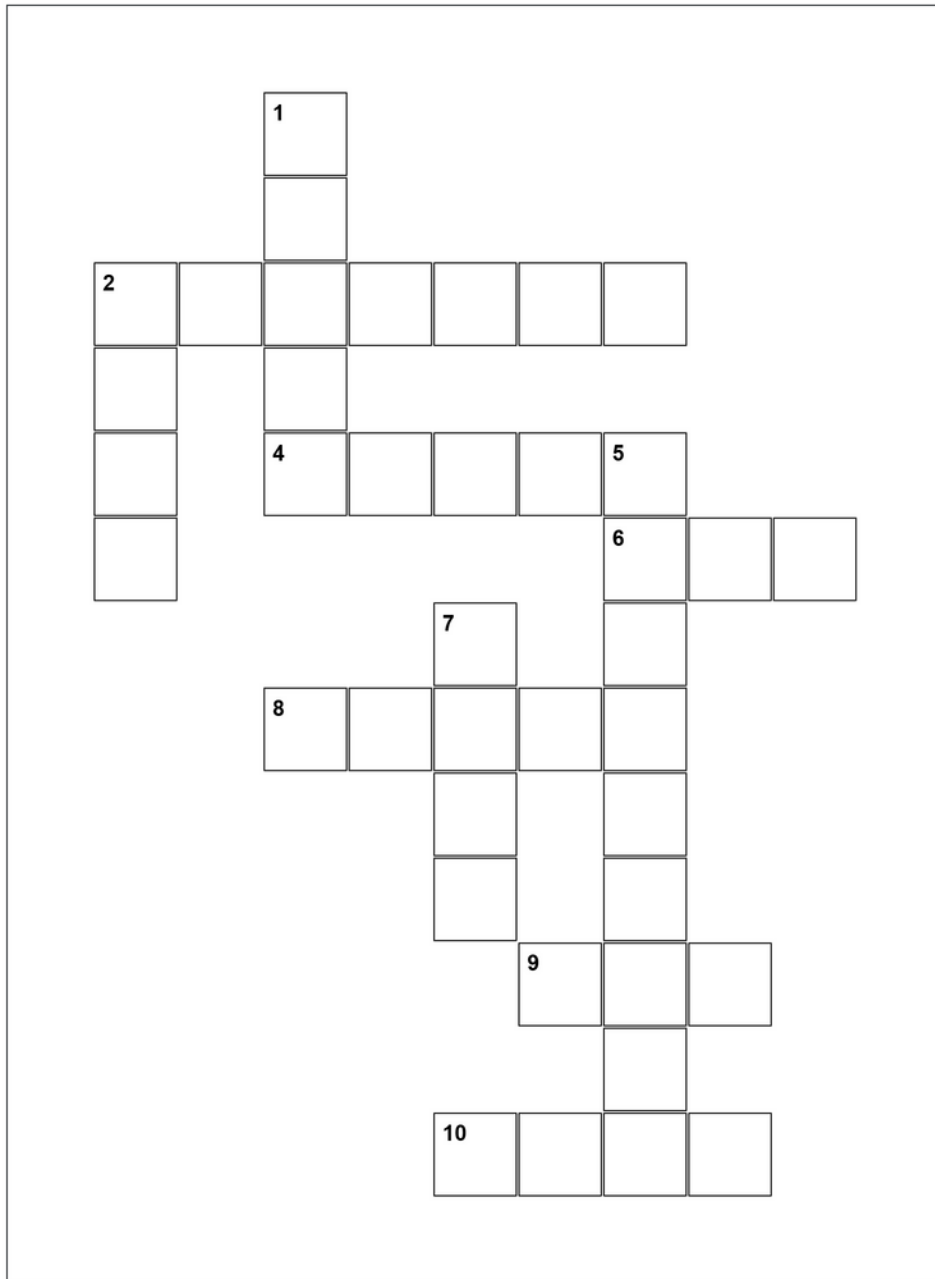

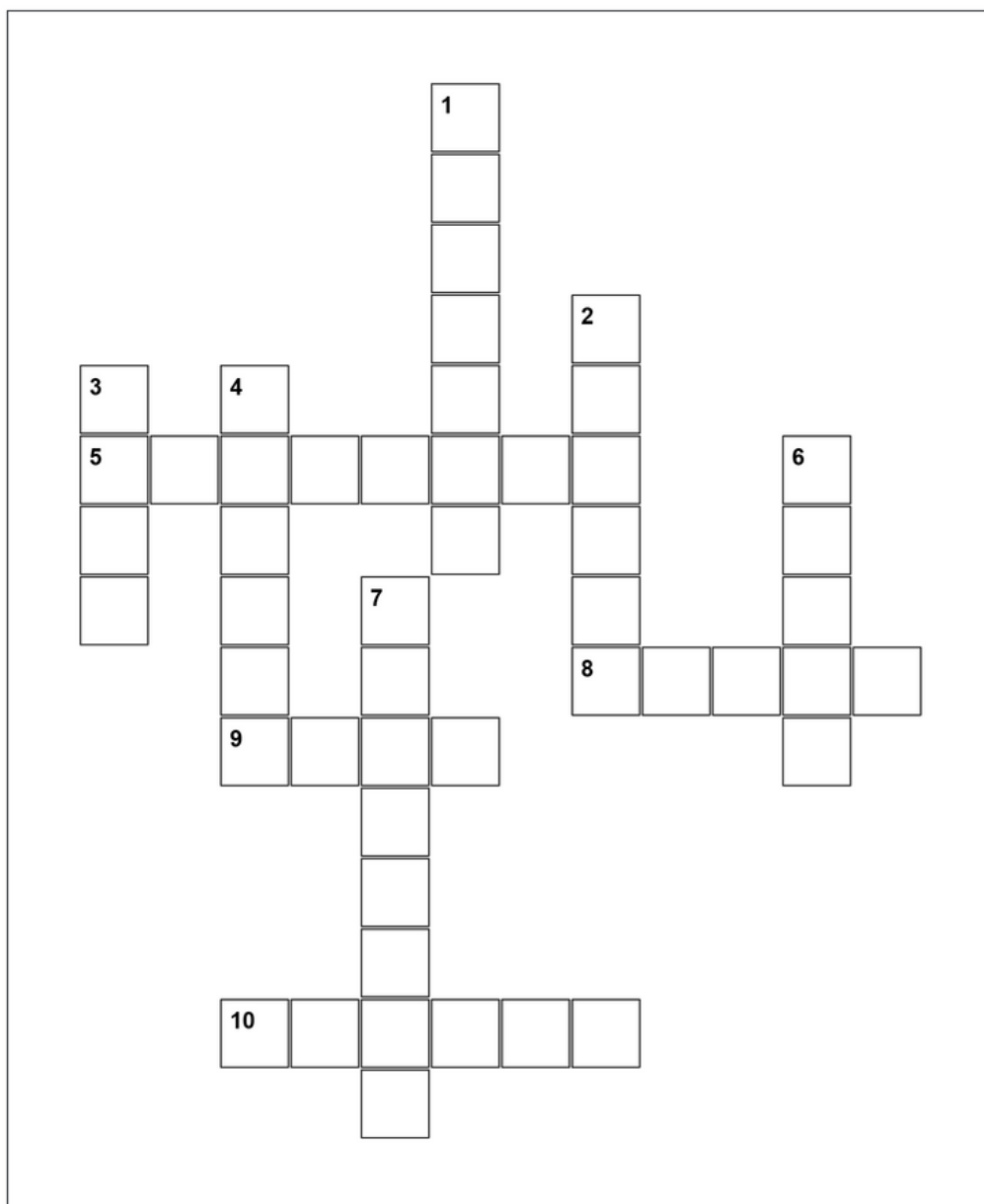

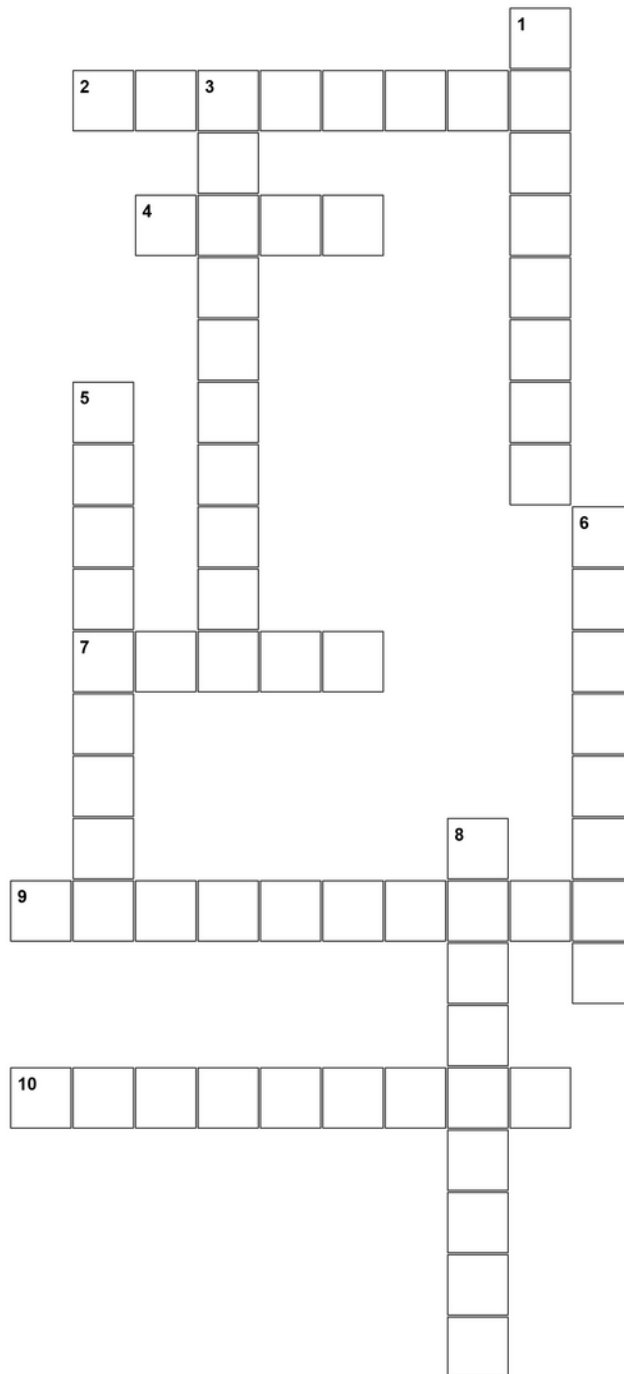

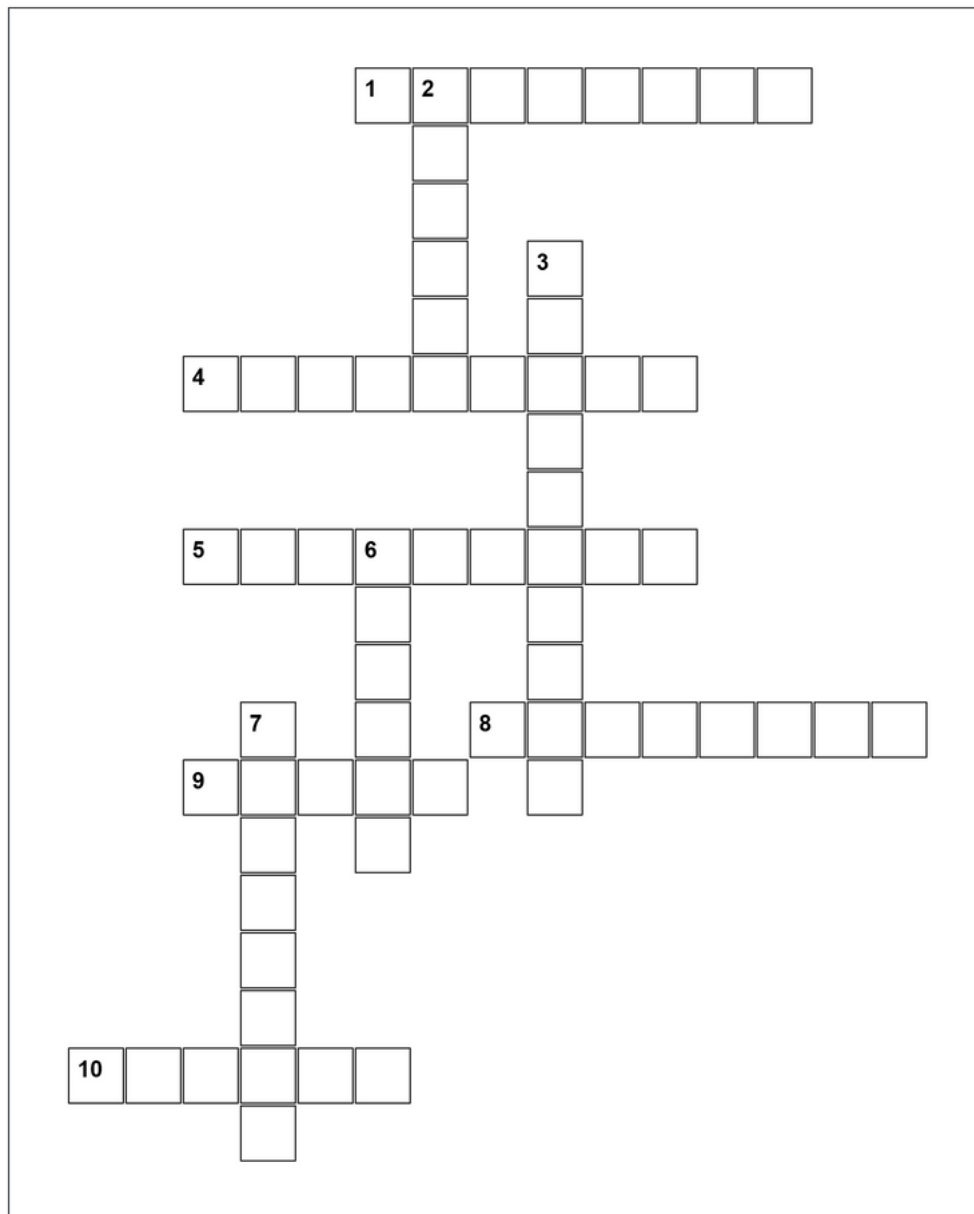
